SCHEDULE

FRIDAY

- Arrive noon and settle into room.
- **LUNCH:** Hunting and firearms safety presentation by Alabama Department of Conservation officer Gordon McGlawn
- Rifle sighting and target practice with .22 rifles; instilling proper bullet placement, shooting form and technique.
- Afternoon Hunt.
- Dinner (steak, hamburgers, and hot dogs) will be cookout style in the Westervelt Lodge courtyard.

SATURDAY

- Morning hunt.
- Saturday midday: Take to the shotgun range for clay target shooting.
- Afternoon hunt.
- Saturday evening: Basic deer biology (antlers, aging, habitat, etc.) will be discussed by Steven Carroll, Westervelt Lodge Manager.
- Dinner will feature a fish fry and campfire in the courtyard.
